

# ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE DR MIRO CERAR GOVERNMENT

**Economic growth** will exceed **4.4% in 2017**, while the **general government deficit** is forecast to fall from 5% of GDP in 2014 to **0.8% in 2017**

**Youth unemployment** has **halved**: from 33,920 in January 2014 to 17,348 in October 2017

**Access to public services from home**: the eUprava portal provides access to 300 procedures in Slovene, more than 80 in Italian and Hungarian, and more than 150 in sign language

An upturn in **funding for education and childcare**: an additional EUR 18 to 20 million for science in 2018

Slovenia is one of the first countries in the EU to put in place a **network of rapid charge points** on its European corridors

To date **EU funding** has been used to support more than 270 projects, programmes and public tenders with a total value of EUR **1.7 billion**

We are encouraging the **use of locally produced food**, and with the **proclamation of world bee day** became the first advocates of the importance of bees to the whole of humanity

**Increased defence spending** and greater security for all

The **Kurent march** has been put on **UNESCO's** representative list of the intangible cultural heritage of humanity; a public tender to co-finance the **renovation of 44 cultural monuments** was held, the first such tender since 2012

**Unemployment** has fallen from almost 130,000 in 2014 to **below 85,000** this year

Healthcare IT solutions: **91%** of all **referrals** are **electronic**, **89%** of all **prescriptions** are now issued in **electronic form**

An effective **fight against white-collar crime** and **improved traffic safety**: according to DARS, instances of speeding have fallen from 30% to 3%

**EUR 198 million** of much-needed investment in **road infrastructure in 2017 alone**

**A reduction in the time taken by court cases**: from 420 days in 2013 to 277 days in 2017

**Inward FDI has been growing** since 2013: FDI amounted to 27.3% of GDP at the end of 2014, but 32.6% of GDP at the end of 2016

An overhaul of planning and construction legislation has **simplified construction** and put more flexible mechanisms in place

**A unified and responsive foreign policy** is strengthening Slovenia's reputation, and properly defending the interests of its citizens, businesses and other legal entities

We are continuing to **expand the network of Slovenian scientists in neighbouring countries and around the world**, and are **strengthening cooperation in cross-border regions**
