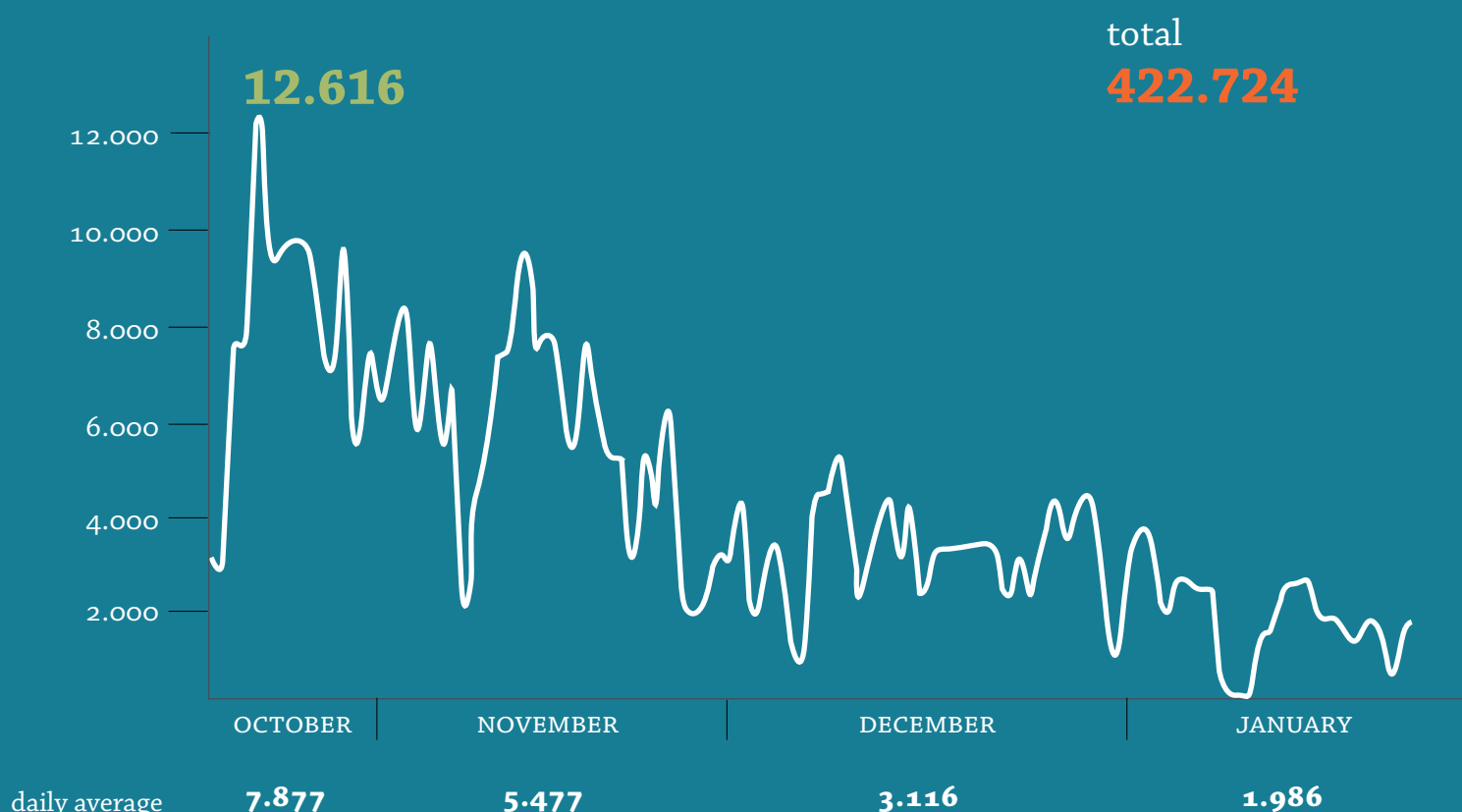

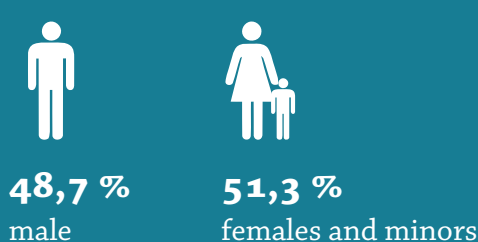
## Migrants crossing Slovenia

in the period between 17 Oct 2015 and 25 Jan 2016

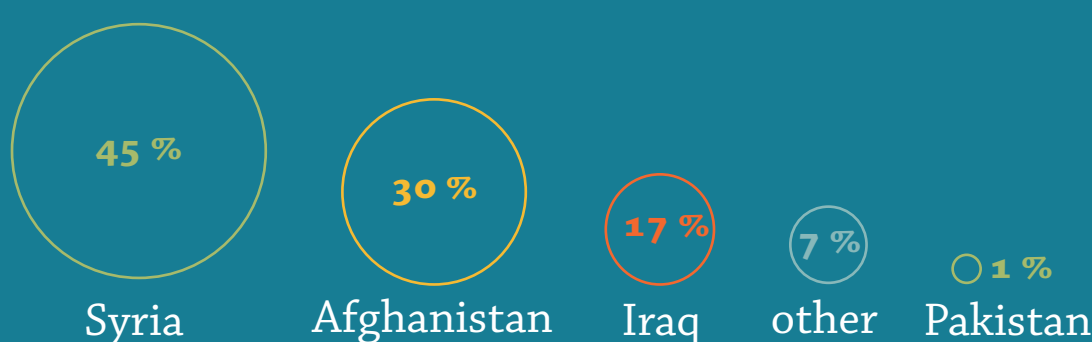


**8.313** current **capacity** of reception and accommodation centres in Slovenia

## Structure of migrants



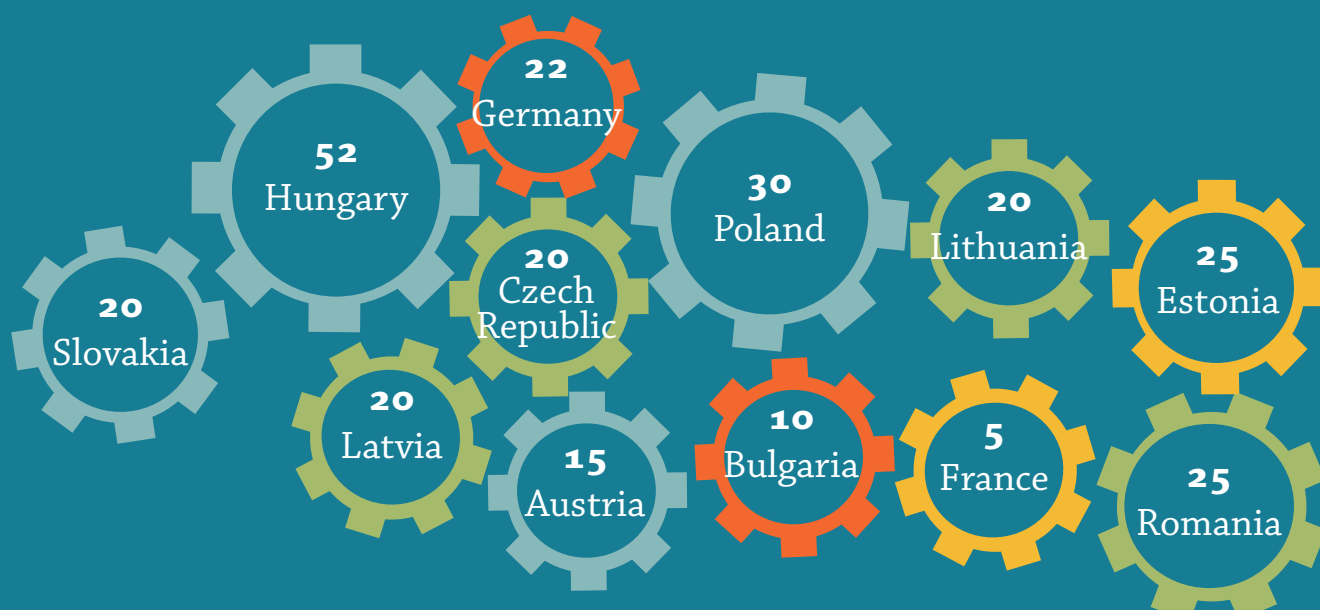
## Citizenship of migrants



on average, **450** members of civil protection services, humanitarian organisations and volunteers are involved daily in **providing accommodation and care for migrants**

every day, between **500 and 1000 police officers** work on **receiving migrants**, with the support of **460 troops** on average

## Assistance of foreign police officers



at the end of January 2016, **149 foreign police officers** were **assisting** the Slovenian police in managing the influx of migrants

**156 kilometres of temporary physical barriers** to protect the external Schengen border

**25 million euros - the cost** of managing the influx of migrants in **2015**

**12 million euros** - international financial **aid**
